

allowed leave of absence or suspended, and who does not subsequently resume the performance of her regular duties for one month at least, is not entitled to have the time of such absence or suspension reckoned as part of her period of approved service.

2. A member of the force who is suspended for a week, or longer, on account of misconduct is not entitled to have the time of such suspension reckoned as part of her period of approved service unless she is reinstated with pay during suspension.

3. A member of the force who is absent from duty without leave is not entitled to have the time of absence reckoned as part of her period of approved service.

Petty Sessions Districts and Times

ORDER, DATED 29TH JANUARY, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

1946. No. 11

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows :—

1. As and from the 1st day of March, 1946, the times when Petty Sessions shall be regularly held in the districts set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Order shall be as set out in the second column of the Schedule opposite the name of the Petty Sessions district.

2. When the time fixed or appointed for the holding of Petty Sessions for any district falls on Christmas Day or Good Friday, the time fixed or appointed for the holding of such Petty Sessions shall be altered to the time fixed or appointed for the next following holding of a Petty Sessions for that district.

3. All previous Orders fixing the times of holding Petty Sessions are hereby revoked.

Separation and Maintenance

RULES, DATED 28TH JUNE, 1946, MADE BY THE LORD CHIEF JUSTICE OF NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (SEPARATION & MAINTENANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945 (Reprint 1946).

1946. No. 161

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR JAMES ANDREWS, Baronet, Deputy Lieutenant, Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 13 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Separation & Maintenance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1945 (Reprint 1946), (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers in that behalf thereunto me enabling do hereby make the following Rules:—

1. The forms set out in the First Schedule to these Rules or forms to the like effect shall be used in proceedings in Courts of Summary Jurisdiction in Northern Ireland under the Act.
