

6. The Registrar-General shall cause to be paid to the Superintendent Registrar or Registrar, at such intervals as may be approved by the Ministry of Finance, a fee of eightpence for each requisition which has been dealt with in accordance with these Regulations.

Scutch Mills and Flax

REGULATION, DATED 23RD SEPTEMBER, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF
AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE SCUTCH MILLS AND FLAX
(FIRE INSURANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1942.

1946. No. 149

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 7 of the Scutch Mills and Flax (Fire Insurance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1942, hereby makes the following Regulation :—

1. Regulation 2 of the Scutch Mills and Flax (Fire Insurance) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, is hereby repealed and the following Regulation substituted therefor :—

“ 2. Every person on whose behalf flax straw is scutched at a scutch mill or flax factory shall pay the sum of one penny per ton or part thereof in respect of all flax fibre produced on his behalf and the amount so paid shall be credited to the Flax Fund.”

2. This Regulation may be cited as the Scutch Mills and Flax (Fire Insurance) (Amendment) Regulation (Northern Ireland), 1946, and shall be construed as one with the Scutch Mills and Flax (Fire Insurance) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, and those Regulations and this Regulation may together be cited as the Scutch Mills and Flax (Fire Insurance) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945 and 1946.
