EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The functions of the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland in relation to the control of civil engineering materials and contractors' plant have been transferred to the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, and the powers formerly delegated to the former Department by the Secretary of State under the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, are now delegated to the latter (see S. R. & O. 1945, No. 789). The purpose of this Order is to make consequential amendments in Orders made by the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland under the delegated powers when those powers were vested in that Department.

ORDER, DATED THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER REGULATION 73 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by paragraph (2) of Regulation 73 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, and delegated to the said Ministry by the Delegation of Emergency Powers (Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland) Order, 1945, hereby makes the following Order :—

1. The Emergency Powers (Defence) (Carriage of Workers) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941, (a) (which provides for the use of a vehicle for specified purposes in contravention of Section 11 of the Motor Vehicles (Traffic and Regulation) Act, (Northern Ireland) 1926, (as amended by Section 6 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, (Northern Ireland) 1929), is hereby revoked.

2. This Order may be cited as "The Emergency Powers (Defence) (Carriage of Workers) (Northern Ireland) (Revocation) Order, 1946."
