INDUSTRIAL ASSURANCE AND FRIENDLY SOCIETIES

Date of Final Determination of Protection

1946. No. 216

WHEREAS by section nine of the Industrial Assurance and Friendly Societies (Emergency Protection from Forfeiture) Act (Northern Ireland), 1940, (a) it is enacted that the provisions of that Act shall not apply as respects any default in the payment of any premium falling due on or after such date as the Minister of Commerce may, by order published in the *Belfast Gazette*; certify to be the date appointed for the purposes of section nine of the Industrial Assurance and Friendly Societies (Emergency Protection from Forfeiture) Act, 1940, (b) passed by the Parliament of the United Kingdom :

AND WHEREAS His Majesty has by Order in Council (c) dated the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and forty-six, and made in pursuance of the said last-mentioned section nine, appointed the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, as the date as respects which the provisions of the last-mentioned Act shall not apply to any default in the payment of any premium falling due thereon or thereafter :

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SENATOR MAJOR THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR ROLAND NUGENT, D.L., Minister of Commerce, do by this Order certify that the date appointed for the purposes of the said last-mentioned section nine is the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-seven.
