REGULATIONS, DATED 18TH DECEMBER, 1946, made by the Ministry of HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936-1946.

1946. No. 222

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the National Health Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1936 to 1946, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations :---

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Amendment (No. 5) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1946, and shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-seven.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2.—(1) Paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), and (i) of Regulation 3 and the whole of Regulation 4 of the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1940 (a) (as amended by the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945) shall cease to have effect on the coming into force of these Regulations but without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done thereunder or to any right,

privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued, or incurred thereunder and the Ministry shall proceed in accordance with paragraph (e) of the said Regulation 3 as if the end of the period of the present emergency had been determined by order in Council.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (e) of the said Regulation 3 advertisement in the local Press shall be deemed to constitute sufficient notification to the insured persons involved.

3. The words "after account has been taken of any adjustments in accordance with paragraph (a) of Regulation 3 of the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1940", shall be deleted from paragraph (i) of Clause 93A of the First Schedule to the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1938.
