Undertakings

(Revocation of Restriction on Engagement)

ORDER DATED MARCH 8th, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATIONS 58A AND 98 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939, AS HAVING EFFECT BY VIRTUE OF THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) ACT, 1945 (a).

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland in pursuance of Regulations 58A and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945 (a), and Orders in Council made thereunder hereby orders as follows :—

1. The Undertakings (Restriction on Engagement) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1942 (b) (which imposes certain restrictions on engagement of workers in general engineering undertakings and electrical installation undertakings) is hereby revoked.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1946.

3. This Order may be cited as Undertakings (Revocation of Restrictions on Engagement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1946.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

Under the Undertakings (Restriction on Engagement) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1942, employers in general engineering and electrical installation undertakings seeking to engage a worker are required to notify particulars of the vacancy to an employment exchange and to fill the vacancy by engaging a worker submitted by the employment exchange. Similarly a worker seeking to engage in any such undertaking is required to register for work at an employment exchange and obtain his employment by means of being submitted to an employer by an employment exchange. The effect of the revocation of the Order will be to dispense with these requirements.
