REGULATIONS, DATED 31ST DECEMBER, 1945, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (HEREINAFTER CALLED "THE MINISTRY") UNDER SECTIONS 73, 75, 76 AND 77 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 (HEREINAFTER CALLED "THE ACT") AS AMENDED BY THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1930, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parliamentary Grant (Education Authorities) Regulations, 1946-47.

2. The Regulations for the payment of the Parliamentary Grant in aid of expenses of Education Authorities in respect of the financial year ending 31st March, 1947, shall be as follows :—

- (i) Regulations 2 to 18 inclusive of those made in respect of the financial year ended 31st March, 1946 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1945, No. 25) subject to the following amendments :—

in Regulations 2 and 13 the year 1947 is substituted for the year 1946.

in Regulation 3 the financial year 1946-47 is substituted for the financial year 1945-46.

Public Elementary Schools Amending Regulations

REGULATIONS, DATED 17TH JULY, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 TO 1942, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 65 and 99 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934, Amending Regulations, No. 22, 1946.

(2) In these Regulations the expression "the Principal Regulations" means the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934, as amended by subsequent Regulations other than these Regulations.

2.—(1) For Article 60 of the Principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following Article:—

"60. Subject to the fulfilment of the other requirements laid down in these Regulations a teacher, to be eligible for appointment as Principal, must—

(a) in the case of a school with an average daily attendance of 30 to 94 pupils have completed his period of probation and be rated as not lower than efficient: Provided that
