## Management of Housing Accommodation

REGULATIONS, DATED 25TH JUNE, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTIONS TWENTY-THREE AND TWENTY-NINE OF THE HOUSING ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in these Regulations referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of section twenty-three and section twenty-nine of the Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1945, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Housing (Management of Accommodation) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1946, and shall be construed as one with the Housing (Management of Accommodation) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945 (in these Regulations referred to as the "principal Regulations").
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Regulation three of the principal Regulations, a housing authority may, with the approval of the Ministry, in selecting tenants or occupiers in respect of accommodation to which the principal Regulations apply, select as a tenant or occupier a person who is a tenant of other housing accommodation provided by the housing authority, provided however that the approval of the Ministry shall not be given unless the housing authority undertakes to let the house vacated by the last-mentioned tenant to a person to whom reasonable preference is required to be given under Regulation three of the principal Regulations.
