- 11. In addition to the appropriate scale salary determined in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations, an allowance, at such rate as may be approved by the Ministry, may be paid to a lecturer or senior lecturer in respect of special responsibilities.
- 12. The scales of salary prescribed in these Regulations shall remain in force until such time as they are varied by Regulations made by the Ministry after consultation with the Ministry of Finance.
- 13. In any case of doubt or difficulty as to the interpretation or application of these Regulations or as to any claim, right or liability thereunder, the decision of the Ministry shall be final.
- 14. The foregoing Regulations shall take and have effect as from the first day of April, 1945.
- 15. The Training College Teachers' (Salaries and Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947 (Statutory Rules and Orders (Northern Ireland), 1947, No. 103) are hereby revoked.

REGULATIONS, DATED 24TH SEPTEMBER, 1947, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 TO 1942, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1947. No. 165

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 65, 69 and 77 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Technical Schools and Classes (Attendance Grants) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.
- (2) In these Regulations the expression "the principal Regulations" means the Technical Attendance Grants Regulations as amended by subsequent Regulations other than these Regulations.

- (3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations.
- 2.—(a) No grant shall be payable by the Ministry to the managers in respect of the attendances of students during the period 1st April to 31st July, 1948.
- (b) The grant in respect of the attendance of pupils during the period commencing 1st August, 1947, and ending 31st March, 1948, shall be an amount equivalent to two-thirds of the sum which would have been paid in accordance with the provisions of the principal Regulations in respect of the school year ending 31st July, 1948, if this Regulation had not come into operation.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Technical School Examinations Regulations, Amending Regulations, No. 2, 1947".
- 2. The Technical School Examinations Regulations, 1933 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1933, No. 109) as amended by subsequent Regulations, are hereinafter referred to as The Principal Regulations.
- 3. The Principal Regulations shall have effect subject to the following provisions of these Regulations.
- **4.** For Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations, there shall be substituted the following Regulation:—
 - "8. Every such form must reach the Ministry not later than the 31st January in the year in which the examinations are to be held and must be accompanied by the prescribed fees, provided, however,
