9. Either party to this Memorandum may terminate the arrangements herein contained on giving not less than three months previous notice in writing to the other party.

REGULATIONS, DATED 14TH OCTOBER, 1947, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION SIX OF THE FIRE SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947.

The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of section six of the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Duties of Fire Officers) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- (3) In these Regulations the expression "fire authority" means a fire authority established under the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1947.
- 2. The duties of fire officers shall be as set forth in the Schedule to these Regulations.
 - 3. These Regulations shall come into force on the date hereof.
