### Unemployment Benefit : Waiting Days

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH FEBRUARY, 1947, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

1947. No. 33

The Ministry of Labour and National Insurance acting in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations :—

Citation and interpretation.

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Waiting Days for Unemployment Benefit) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.

(2) In these regulations the expression “ the Act of 1936 ” means the Unemployment Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, as amended by any subsequent enactment, order or regulation.

Waiting days for unemployment.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. For subsection (6) of section 32 of the Act of 1936 (which provides for the date as from which benefit under that Act is payable) there shall be substituted the following subsection :—

“(6) Benefit shall be payable in respect of each week of a continuous period of unemployment :

Provided that benefit shall not be payable in respect of any of the first three days of any such period, unless it is a day not earlier than the tenth day of February, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, and unless, within the period of thirteen weeks beginning with the first of those three days or the tenth day of February, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, whichever is the later, an insured contributor has been unemployed for a further nine days in the same continuous period of unemployment.”
