

Health Authorities, Transfer of Functions**Supervision of Nursing Homes**

ORDER, DATED 26TH DAY OF APRIL, 1947, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Public Health and Local Government (Administrative Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, hereby orders as follows :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Public Health and Local Government (Transfer of Functions) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1947.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921 applies for the purpose of the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The functions exercisable immediately before the first day of May, 1947 by the council of a county or county borough under the Midwives and Nursing Homes Act (Northern Ireland), 1929 shall as from the first day of May, 1947, be performed by the health committee for the area of that county or county borough.

3.—(1) References to a local authority where they occur in Part II of the Midwives and Nursing Homes Act (Northern Ireland), 1929 shall, as from the first day of May, 1947, be construed as references to a health authority.

(2) There shall be made in any other enactment such modifications and adaptations as may be required to bring it into conformity with the provisions of this Order.
