

3. The following provision shall be added after paragraph (b) of the said proviso :—

“(c) if a married woman (not being a person to whom paragraph (a) of this proviso applies) is entitled to a pension under the Contributory Pensions Acts in respect of the insurance of her husband on the date on which her husband is deemed under this regulation to have retired from regular employment or, if he is not so deemed, on which he attains the age of seventy, then if, but for the provisions of this regulation relating to notice, she could be treated thereunder as having retired from regular employment on or before the foregoing relevant date, she shall, if she gives notice to the Ministry in writing of her retirement not later than four weeks after that date (or within such further time as the Ministry may in any particular case for special reasons allow), be deemed to have retired on that date ;”

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH APRIL, 1947, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Labour and National Insurance, acting in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations :—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Increase of Contributory Pensions) Amendment Regulations (No. 2)

(Northern Ireland), 1947, and shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Increase of Contributory Pensions) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1946, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

(2) In these regulations, the expression "question" shall include any matters which may, under paragraph (a) of the proviso to paragraph (2) of regulation (9), or under sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (2) of regulation 10, of the principal regulations be determined by the Ministry, and the expression "decide any question" in regulation 2 shall be construed accordingly.

2. Where under the provisions of the principal regulations the Ministry may decide any question and that decision is subject to an appeal to a court of referees, the Ministry may, if it thinks fit, instead of deciding that question, refer it to a court of referees, and, in relation to any question so referred, the principal regulations shall apply, subject to the necessary modifications, as they apply to an appeal from a decision of the Ministry.
