The Utility Furniture (Supply and Acquisition) (Northern IRELAND) (No. 2) ORDER, 1948, DATED 17TH JUNE, 1948, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATIONS 55 AND 98 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGU-LATIONS, 1939.

In exercise of the powers under Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945 (a), as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947 (b), delegated to it by an Instrument of Delegation dated the 2nd day of July, 1946, made by the Board of Trade under the said Regulations, as having effect as aforesaid, and of all other powers it enabling, the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland hereby orders as follows:

- The control of the supply and acquisition of reserved utility furniture shall cease, and accordingly the Utility Furniture (Supply and Acquisition) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1946 (c) and the Utility Furniture (Supply and Acquisition) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1948 (d) are hereby revoked.
- This Order may be cited as the Utility Furniture (Supply and Acquisition) (Northern Ireland) (No. 2) Order, 1948, and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of June, 1948.
