

ORDER, DATED 9TH JULY, 1948, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION TWENTY OF THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

WHEREAS by Section 20 (1) of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, (in this Order called " the Act ") it is provided that the Minister of Health and Local Government shall by Order constitute, in accordance with the First Schedule to the Act, a body to be called the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority ;

AND WHEREAS an Order under the said provisions of the Act, entitled the Health Services (Constitution of the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority) Order (Northern Ireland), 1948, was made on the 25th March, 1948 (a) ;

AND WHEREAS the said Order was amended by the Health Services (Constitution of the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland), 1948 (b) ;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the first-mentioned Order :

NOW THEREFORE I, the Right Honourable William Grant, J.P., M.P., Minister of Health and Local Government do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Services (Constitution of the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1948.

2. The Health Services (Constitution of the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority) Order (Northern Ireland), 1948, shall have effect as if in Article 2 thereof there were added to the list of members the name of :—
