REGULATIONS, DATED 31ST AUGUST, 1948, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (e) OF SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION SIX OF THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph (e) of sub-section (2) of Section six of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948 (in these Regulations referred to as "the Act"), hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Medical Certificates) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2. Medical practitioners providing services under Section six of the Act shall issue to, or on behalf of, patients, or their personal representatives, certificates reasonably required by them under or for the purposes of the enactments set forth in the Schedule to these Regulations.
- 3. The Health Services (Medical Certificates) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 (a) and the Health Services (Medical Certificates) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 (b) are hereby revoked.
