REGULATIONS, DATED 3RD MARCH, 1948, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN OF THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

1948. No. 40

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in these Regulations referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section thirty-seven of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948 (in these Regulations referred to as "the Act"), hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Submission of Health Authority Proposals) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2. Every health authority shall, within such period as the Ministry may specify, submit to the Ministry proposals for performing their functions under section forty of the Act.
