#### WAGES COUNCILS

AND WHEREAS no objections to the making of such an order were received by me :

Now, THEREFORE, I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE EDMOND WARNOCK, K.C., Minister of Home Affairs, hereby order and direct :

1. That the mute swan shall be classified under the Act as being in Category I and the eggs and nests of such bird shall be deemed to be protected at all times, during the operation of the Order.

2. That so much of the Order dated 20th March, 1935, (Statutory Rule and Order of Northern Ireland, 1935, No. 46) as relates to the mute swan shall be suspended during the operation of this Order.

3. That this Order shall come into operation immediately on the expiration of the Order dated 30th April, 1946, (Statutory Rule and Order of Northern Ireland, 1946, No. 58), and shall remain in operation until the 1st March, 1950.
