REGULATIONS DATED 14TH JANUARY, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTIONS EIGHT, NINE AND THIRTY-FOUR OF THE DEVELOP-MENT OF TOURIST TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland (in these Regulations referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of section nine and sub-section (1) of section thirty-four of the Development of Tourist Traffic Act (Northern Ireland), 1948 (in these Regulations referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

General

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Tourist Traffic (Finance) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1949.

(2) In these Regulations the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them, that is to say :---

"the Board" means the Northern Ireland Tourist Board;

"financial year" means the twelve months ending thirty-first day of March.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2.—(1) The Board shall keep :—

Records and Books of Account

(a) Such records, books of account and supporting vouchers as are necessary to show its financial transactions; and

(b) Records in sufficient detail of :---

- (i) lands, buildings, furniture and other permanent equipment acquired and held by the Board;
- (ii) property or assets of the Board sold, let, mortgaged, disposed of or turned to account.

(2) All accounts and records of the Board shall be available for inspection by duly authorised officers of the Ministry.

(3) The Board shall furnish to the Ministry such information in connection with its operations as the Ministry may from time to time require.

3.—(1) The accounts to be submitted annually through the Min-Annual istry to the Comptroller and Auditor-General in accordance with sub-Accounts section (2) of section nine of the Act shall be signed by the Chairman and the General Manager, and shall be forwarded to the Ministry by the Board not later than 31st August following the close of each financial year. The Accounts shall consist of the following :—

(a) an Income and Expenditure Account;

(b) a Balance Sheet;

(c) Details of any trusts undertaken, and gifts or donations of a capital nature accepted by the Board.

(2) The accounts shall be so prepared as to present a full and correct view of the transactions and state of affairs of the Board. The form of the Accounts shall be such as shall be accepted by the Ministry after consultation with the Ministry of Finance.

4. In accordance with Section 8 of the Act, the Board shall prepare Annual and submit to the Ministry not later than 30th June in each year a Report report of the Board's work during the preceding financial year.

5. The first Accounts to be rendered by the Board shall be in respect First of the period from the date of establishment of the Board up to the Accounts 31st March, 1949.
