ORDER, DATED 28TH JANUARY, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH
AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE MENTAL HEALTH ACT (NOR-
THERN IRELAND), 1948.

1949. No. 14

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland
(in this Order referred to as " the Ministry "), in exercise of the powers
conferred on it by the Mental Health Act (Northern Ireland), 1948
(in this Order referred to as " the Act ") and of all other powers enab-
ling it in that behalf, hereby orders as follows :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Mental Health (Institutions)
Order (Northern Ireland), 1949, and shall come into operation on the
1st day of February, 1949.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of
the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies for the
interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The Ministry approves of the use of the hospitals specified in
the first column of the Schedule hereto, to the extent specified in the
third column of the Schedule, as institutions, for the purposes of Part
III of the Act.

MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS

ORDER, DATED TWENTY SIXTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE MILK ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1944.

1949. No. 166

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 1 of the Milk Act (Northern Ireland) 1944 (a), and of any other powers enabling it in that behalf doth by this Order determine :

1. The Safe Milk Order No. 1 of 1945 (b), shall be amended by the substitution of the Schedule hereto for the Schedule appearing in that Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Safe Milk Order No. 1 of 1949 and shall come into operation on the first day of November nineteen hundred and forty-nine.
