PARAGRAPH 8.

The general minimum time rates specified in paragraphs 1 to 6 of this Schedule are weekly rates based on a week of 45 hours, or, in the case of workers who are under 16 years of age, on a week of 44 hours; for the purpose of calculating the minimum rate in respect of each hour of employment the respective rates must be divided by 45 or 44 as the case may be."

GENERAL MINIMUM PIECE RATES FOR FEMALE IN-WORKERS AND OUT-WORKERS OF ALL AGES

PARAGRAPH 2.

Paragraphs 9 to 13 of the Schedule to Order N.I.B. (36) shall be amended as follows :—

The general minimum piece rates set out in the said paragraphs shall be subject to an increase of 130 per cent. instead of 110 per cent. as specified in the heading to the said paragraphs.

WHEREAS, by virtue of section twenty-one of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland), 1945 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") the

Ministry of Labour and National Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") is empowered by Order to direct that on such date as may be specified the constitution of any Wages Council that was in existence as a Trade Board at the commencement of the Act shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Act ;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry by virtue of the powers conferred by the said section and of every other power in that behalf hereby makes the following Order :—

1. As from the date of this Order the constitution of the Paper Box Wages Council (Northern Ireland) shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Paper Box Wages Council (Northern Ireland) (Constitution) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the date hereof.

Readymade and Wholesale Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (Northern Ireland)

THE READYMADE AND WHOLESALE BESPOKE TAILORING WAGES COUNCIL (NORTHERN IRELAND) WAGES REGULATION (HOLIDAYS) ORDER, 1949, DATED 25TH JULY, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945 (9 & 10 GEO. 6, CH. 21).

WHEREAS the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") has received from the Readymade and Wholesale Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (Northern Ireland) wages regulation proposals for requiring workers in relation to whom the Council operates to be allowed by their employers the holidays set out in the Schedule to this Order and for fixing the holiday remuneration specified therein in substitution for the holidays provided, and holiday remuneration fixed, for these workers by the Readymade and Wholesale Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Holidays) Order,
