

Training Scholarships Amending Regulations, 1949

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH OCTOBER, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACT, (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1949. No. 187

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Training Colleges (Scholarships) Amending Regulations, 1949.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof.

3. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Training Colleges (Scholarships) Regulations, (Northern Ireland), 1948.

4. For Paragraph 4 (ii) of the Schedule to the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Paragraph :—

“ 4 (ii) expenditure which, in the opinion of the Ministry, is reasonably incurred by the parent on the education of members of the family other than the applicant.”

5. For Paragraph 5 (iii) of the Schedule to the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Paragraph :—

“ 5 (iii) endowment scholarships and other private awards held by members of the family other than the applicant, and any sums contributed by relatives or other persons towards the cost of educating members of the family.”
