

Industries Development Loans — Transfer

ORDER MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 3 (1) OF THE INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948, TRANSFERRING TO THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE CERTAIN INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT LOANS.

WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section 1 of section 3 of the Industries Development (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), that the Ministry of Finance may from time to time by Order transfer to the Ministry of Commerce, any loan or class of Industries Development loans issued (whether from the Government Loans Fund or from moneys provided by Parliament) before the passing of the Act under any of the provisions of the New Industries (Development) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1937 and 1944, or of the Industries Development Act (Northern Ireland), 1945.

NOW, THEREFORE, in the exercise of these powers, and of all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Ministry of Finance hereby directs and orders as follows :—

1. As from the date of this Order the classes of Industries Development loans as set out in the Schedule hereto shall be transferred to the Ministry of Commerce, and the provisions of section three of the Act, so far as they are applicable, shall apply thereto.

2. This Order may be cited as the Industries Development Loans Transfer Order (Northern Ireland), 1949.

Grammar Schools (Grant Conditions) Amending Regulations, 1949

REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH JULY, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF
EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND),
1947, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1949. No. 114

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations :

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Grammar School (Grant Conditions) Amending Regulations, 1949.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of August, 1949.

3. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Grammar School (Grant Conditions) Regulations, 1948.

4. For Paragraph 8 of the Third Schedule to the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Paragraph :—

" 8. In addition to the grants payable under the preceding paragraphs the Ministry shall pay a grant not exceeding one half the expenditure incurred by the school authorities in the employment of a person, other than a teacher, who is engaged, in accordance with arrangements approved by the Ministry, for the purposes of giving assistance in the teaching of modern languages."
