ORDER IN COUNCIL, DATED 25TH APRIL, 1949, MADE UNDER SECTION TWELVE OF THE TEACHERS' SALARIES AND SUPERANNUATION (WAR SERVICE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939.

BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND

GRANVILLE

WHEREAS by section twelve of the Teachers' Salaries and Superannuation (War Service) Act (Northern Ireland), 1939, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") it is provided that the Governor of Northern Ireland may by Order in Council declare the date on which the emergency that was the occasion of the passing of the Act came to an end:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM SPENCER, EARL GRANVILLE, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Vice-Admiral, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section twelve of the Act, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries and Superannuation (War Service) Act (End of Emergency) Order (Northern Ireland), 1949.

2. It is hereby declared that the twentieth day of April One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine is the date on which the

emergency that was the occasion of the passing of the Act came to an end.

Teachers' Salaries (Abatement During Absence Owing to Illness)

REGULATIONS DATED 17TH JUNE, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 83, 84, 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries (Abatement During Absence Owing to Illness) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1949.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st August, 1949.

2. For the purpose of these Regulations :—

"teacher" means any person engaged in teaching in any school recognised by the Ministry ;

"paying authority" means the Ministry in the case of a teacher who is paid salary direct by the Ministry, and in the case of a teacher who is paid salary by any other authority or body, such authority or body.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Regulations relating to the salaries or the conditions of service of teachers, the salary of a teacher who is absent owing to illness and who, under the provisions of the National Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1946, is entitled to receive either sickness benefit or injury benefit, shall be abated as follows in respect of each day for which such benefit is payable to him :—
