

MALONE TRAINING SCHOOL

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST DECEMBER, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SUB-SECTION (3) OF SECTION THREE OF THE MALONE TRAINING SCHOOL ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by sub-section (3) of Section Three of the Malone Training School Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. The contribution payable by the council of a county or county borough under the said sub-section in respect of a youthful offender in the School referred to in that sub-section during any period or periods occurring after the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty, and before the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, shall be at the rate of thirty-nine shillings and ten pence (39s. 10d.) for each week during which he is so detained.

2. Payment of the contribution as aforesaid shall be in arrear, and shall be made half-yearly by the council of the county or county borough in respect of the half years ending 30th September and 31st March, respectively, and shall be made not later than two months from the date of the claim for payment.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Malone Training School (Contributions) Regulations, 1950.
