

REGULATIONS, DATED 18TH DECEMBER, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926-45.

1950. No. 220

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Acts (Northern Ireland), 1926-45, and of all other powers in that behalf thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations, amending the Motor Cars (Speed) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations"), that is to say :—

1. Sub-paragraph (1) of Article 1 of the Principal Regulations shall have effect as though the following definition were substituted for the definition of "Unladen Weight" therein contained :—

"Unladen Weight" means, in relation to a motor car, the unladen weight of that motor car as registered by a council in pursuance of the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1947.

2.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Cars (Speed) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889 (b), shall apply for the purposes of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies, by virtue of the Interpretation Act, 1921 (c), for the purposes of the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

NATIONAL ASSISTANCE

Determination of Need

REGULATIONS, DATED 16TH MAY, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE UNDER SECTIONS 5 AND 6 OF THE NATIONAL ASSISTANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

1950. No. 84

The Ministry of Labour and National Insurance by virtue of the powers conferred on it by sections 5 and 6 of the National Assistance Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, hereby makes the following regulations:—

(b) 52 and 53 Vict. c.63. (c) 12 Geo. 5 Ch. 4 (N.I.).

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Assistance (Determination of Need) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950, and may be cited together with the National Assistance (Determination of Need) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal regulations ”) as the National Assistance (Determination of Need) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 and 1950.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 12th June, 1950.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the interpretation of these regulations in like manner as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

Amendment of scales for the computation of requirements other than rent

2.—(1) Paragraph 2 of Part I of the Schedule to the principal regulations (which provides the ordinary scale for computing the requirements other than rent of an applicant for assistance) shall have effect as if for the sums specified in the said paragraph there were substituted the sums following :—

REGULATIONS, DATED 13TH MARCH, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

1950. No. 60

The Ministry of Labour and National Insurance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations :—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance (Claims and Payments) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950, shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Claims and Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”) and shall come into operation on the 13th March, 1950.

Amendment of the principal regulations

2.—(1) Paragraph (2) of regulation 11 of the principal regulations as amended shall be amended in accordance with the next following paragraph, and the said regulation 11 shall have effect as set out in the schedule to these regulations.
