

### Contributions during service in the Forces

REGULATIONS, DATED 28TH MAY, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE (INDUSTRIAL INJURIES) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

1951. No. 107

The Ministry of Labour and National Insurance, in exercise of powers conferred by subsection (3) of section 3 of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations :—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) (Contributions during service in the Forces) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951; and shall come into operation on the 28th May, 1951. Citation, commencement and interpretation.

(2) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —  
“ the Act ” means the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946 ;

“ insured person ” means an insured person under the Act ;

“ contributions ” means contributions under the Act ;

and other expressions have the same meanings as in the Act.

(3) References in these regulations to any enactment or regulations shall include references to such enactment or regulations as amended by any subsequent enactment, order or regulations.

(4) The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the interpretation of these regulations in like manner as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. Where, as respects any insurable employment, no services are rendered by an insured person during any period, and throughout the whole of that period he has been employed in the naval, military or air force service of the Crown, then, as respects that employment, any payments which he receives in respect of any day in that period or which, apart from these regulations, would be deemed to be remuneration paid in respect of any such day shall, for the purposes of those provisions of Part I of the Act which relate to the payment and recovery of contributions, be deemed not to be such remuneration. Contributions during naval, military or air force service.
