#### EDUCATION

"Provided that if the managers of a school which has been classified in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph as a Group B voluntary school subsequently request the Ministry to classify the school as a Group A voluntary school, and the Ministry is satisfied that having regard to the existing school provision in the area it is expedient that the school should be so classified, the Ministry may from such date as it may determine classify such school as a Group A voluntary School."

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Voluntary Grammar Schools Meals Grant Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) No. 2, 1951.
