THE COAL SUPPLY (NORTHERN IRELAND) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 1) ORDER, 1951.

1951. No. 190

In exercise of the powers under Regulations 55 and 55AA (1) of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, (a) (as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947, (b) and the Supplies and Services (Defence Purposes) Act, 1951, (c) and continued in force by the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1950, (d) delegated to it by instruments of delegation made respectively by the Board of Trade on 26th May, 1941, and the Minister of Fuel and Power on 16th October, 1943, under the said Regulations, as having effect as aforesaid, and of all other powers it enabling, the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland (hereafter in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Coal Supply (Northern Ireland) Order, 1951, (e), (hereafter in this Order referred to as "the principal Order") shall have effect subject to the modifications specified in this order.

2. The following paragraph shall be substituted for paragraph (a) of Article 6 of the principal Order:—

(a) the supply or acquisition of coal in a quantity not exceeding at any one time in the case of:—

(i) coke, fifty six pounds

(ii) any other class or description of coal, twenty-eight pounds.

3. In paragraph (i) of Article 12 of the principal Order (which relates to the interpretation of that Order) the following sub-paragraphs shall be substituted for sub-paragraphs (c) and (d):—

(c) coke

(d) anthracite and

(e) manufactured fuel (other than coke) which is carbonised to any extent in the process of manufacture and of which any one of the foregoing is the principal constituent.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty one, and may be cited as the Coal Supply (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1951.

1. The Advertisement Lighting (Prohibition) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1951 (e), is hereby revoked.
