Return of Hospital Endowments

REGULATIONS, DATED 2ND NOVEMBER, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTIONS TWO AND FIVE OF THE HEALTH SERVICES (HOSPITAL ENDOWMENTS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1951.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in these Regulations referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections two and five of the Health Services (Hospital Endowments) Act (Northern Ireland), 1951, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Return of Hospital Endowments) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The form in which the secretary of each hospital management committee shall furnish to the Ministry a statement of the endowments of each voluntary hospital under the control of the Committee, which vested in the Committee by virtue of the terms of sub-section (1) of section twenty-five of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, and the Health Services (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland), 1951 (a), shall be the form set out in Part I of the Schedule to these Regulations or a form to the like effect.

3. The form in which the secretary of each hospital management committee shall furnish to the Ministry a statement of the property which was held prior to 1st August, 1951, solely for the purposes of each local authority hospital under the control of the Committee and to which the provisions of section twenty-five of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, apply, shall be the form set out in Part II of the Schedule to these Regulations or a form to the like effect.

4. The form in which the secretary of each hospital management committee shall furnish to the Ministry a statement of the payments whether of the capital or income of trust property which trustees by virtue of section thirty-four of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, made in respect of each hospital under the control of the Committee during the period commencing 5th July, 1948, and ending on 31st July, 1951, shall be the form set out in Part III of the Schedule to these Regulations or a form to the like effect.

5. Each statement furnished in accordance with Regulations Two, Three and Four of these Regulations, shall be certified to be correct by the secretary of the hospital management committee or the officer acting as secretary for the time being, and he shall furnish to the Ministry a statutory declaration in respect of each hospital in the form set out in Part IV of the Schedule to these Regulations.
