REGULATIONS, DATED THE 20TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1951, MADE BY THE
 MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD
 TRAFFIC ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926 TO 1945.

The Ministry of Commerce, in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Acts (Northern Ireland), 1926 to 1945, and of all other powers in this behalf thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations further amending the Motor Cars (Use and Construction) Regulations, 1934 (a) (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Regulations"), that is to say:—

1. The proviso to Article 46 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked, and the following proviso is substituted therefor:

Provided that this Regulation shall not apply to a trailer not exceeding 2 cwts. in weight unladen, or to any trailer designed and used by or on behalf of local authorities for street cleansing which does not carry any load other than its necessary gear and equipment, or to a two-wheeled agricultural trailer.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Cars (Use and Construction) (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1951.

Public Service Vehicles (Construction)

THE PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES (CONSTRUCTION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1951, DATED THE 14TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND.

The Ministry of Commerce in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Part II of the Motor Vehicles (Traffic and Regulations) Act (Northern Ireland), 1926 (b), and all other powers on that behalf thereunto

enabling it hereby makes the following Regulations, further amending the Public Service Vehicles (Construction) Regulations, 1932 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations"), that is to say :—

1. The Principal Regulations shall have effect as though in paragraph 3 in Part I of the Schedule thereto, as amended by the Public Service Vehicles (Construction) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950 (b), the following sub-paragraph were substituted for sub-paragraph (b) thereof :—

" (b) four wheels and is a single-decked vehicle shall not exceed 30 feet."

2.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as "The Public Service Vehicles (Construction) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889 (c), shall apply for the purposes of interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applied, by virtue of the Interpretation Act, 1921 (d), for the purposes of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament of Northern Ireland.

Public Service Vehicles

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH DAY OF MARCH, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926-45.

The Ministry of Commerce in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Acts (Northern Ireland), 1926-45, and of all other powers in that behalf thereunto enabling it, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland in regard to the provisions contained in Regulations 10, 23, and 34 hereof, hereby makes the following Regulations with respect to the Licensing and Regulation of Public Service Vehicles and matters incidental thereto, that is to say :—

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1951.
