Milk Licences (Temporary Provisions) Regulations, 1951

REGULATIONS, DATED 31ST MARCH, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE MILK ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

1951. No. 60

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section nine of the Milk Act (Northern Ireland), 1950 (in these Regulations referred to as "the Act") and of any other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say :—

1. For the purposes of the Act producers' and distributors' licences granted under the Milk and Milk Products Acts (Northern Ireland) 1934-44 and in force on the thirty-first day of March, 1951 shall, as from that day have effect as follows :—

- (1) a licence for the production and sale of Grade A milk shall be deemed to be a "Grade A. T.T. licence" granted by the Ministry under the Act on that day;
- (2) a licence for the production and sale of Grade B milk shall be deemed to be a "Grade B licence" granted by the Ministry under the Act on that day;
- (3) a licence for the production and sale of Grade C milk or a Milk Licence shall be deemed to be a "Milk Licence" granted by the Ministry under the Act on that day; and
- (4) a distributor's licence shall be deemed to be a "distributor's licence" granted by the Ministry under the Act on that day.

2. Unless suspended or revoked or surrendered by the holder, producers' licences and distributors' licences shall remain in force until 31st October, 1951.

3. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Milk Licences (Temporary Provisions) Regulations 1951 and shall come into operation on the 31st day of March, 1951.
