Nursery Schools

REGULATIONS, DATED 7TH MAY, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1951. No. 83

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by sections 83, 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Nursery Schools (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1951.
- 2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Nursery Schools Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.
- 3. For Regulation 11 (1) of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Regulation:—
 - "11.—(1) A nursery school shall be open for not less than 205 school days in each school year: provided that in exceptional circumstances the Ministry may approve a lesser number of days of opening."
