2. The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1951.

1. In pursuance of sub-sections (3) (b) and (4) of section three of the Intoxicating Liquor Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, as amended by the Intoxicating Liquor (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, the Ministry of Finance hereby prescribes that the rates at which charges are

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to be levied in respect of all licences for the sale of intoxicating liquor by retail granted or renewed during the year ending the 30th day of September, 1952, shall be fourteen shillings and tenpence for each pound sterling of the maximum rates of charge authorised by subsection (1) of section one of the Intoxicating Liquor (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1925.

2. This Order may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Compensation Charges) Order (Northern Ireland), 1951.
