REGULATIONS, DATED 22ND JULY, 1952, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION EIGHTEEN OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934.

1952. No. 127

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in these Regulations referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers vested in it by section eighteen of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934 and of every other power in that behalf enabling the Ministry, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Borough and Urban District Councils (Officers Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952.
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921 shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2. In sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of Regulation 2 of the Borough and Urban District Councils (Officers Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1946 (a), after the words "The Chartered Institute of Secretaries", there shall be added the words "The Corporation of Certified Secretaries, Limited".
