

REGULATIONS, DATED 5TH AUGUST, 1952, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE HOUSING AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Housing and Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Housing (Houses Built for Letting) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952, and shall be construed as one with the Housing (Houses Built for Letting) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952 (a) (in these Regulations referred to as “ the principal Regulations ”).

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The principal Regulations shall have effect as if for the words and figure “ ceiling height of less than 6 feet ” in paragraph (2) of Schedule III, there were substituted the words and figure “ ceiling height of less than 5 feet ” and for the words “ six feet ” in paragraph (3) of Schedule V, there were substituted the words “ five feet ”.
