

**Foot and Mouth Disease No. XII Order  
(Northern Ireland), 1952**

1952. No. 220

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Acts 1894, as amended and adapted by subsequent Enactments, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. From and after midnight on Friday, the fifth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Export Prohibition) No. VIII Order (Northern Ireland) 1952 is hereby revoked, provided such revocation shall not affect anything already done under that Order.

*Short Title*

2. This Order is cited as “ The Foot-and-Mouth Disease No. XII Order (Northern Ireland) 1952 ”.

**Landing of Carcasses Order (Northern Ireland) 1952**

1952. No. 191

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Acts (Northern Ireland), 1894 to 1948, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders as follows :—

*Prohibition of landing of Carcasses in Northern Ireland*

1. On and after 1st October, 1952, the landing of carcasses of animals in Northern Ireland is hereby prohibited except under licence granted by the Ministry.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Order —

“ Animals ” means cattle, sheep, goats, and all other ruminating animals, and swine ;

“ Carcase ” means the carcase of the animal, and includes part of a carcase, and the meat, bones, hide, skin, hoofs, horns, offal, or other part of an animal, separately or otherwise, or any portion thereof ;

“ The Ministry ” means the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland.

#### *Offences*

3. If any carcase shall be landed in contravention of this Order, the owner thereof and the owner, and lessee and the occupier of the place of landing and the person causing, directing, or permitting the landing and the owner or charterer, and the Master of the Vessel from which the same is landed, shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts and defaults be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act 1894.

#### *Revocation*

4. The Landing of Carcases Order of 1926 is hereby revoked.

#### *Short Title*

5. This Order may be cited as “ The Landing of Carcases Order (Northern Ireland) 1952.”
