WHEREAS the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") has received from the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) wages regulation proposals for the further amendment of the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (No. 5) Order, 1951 (a) (hereinafter in this Order referred to as "Order N.I.Bk. (149)") dated the 21st day of December, 1951, as amended by the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1952 (b) dated the 16th day of June, 1952, and the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1952 (c) dated the 18th day of September, 1952, which fixes the minimum remuneration to be paid to certain workers in relation to whom the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) operates;

Now, THEREFORE, the Ministry by virtue of section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland), 1945, and of every other power in that behalf hereby makes the following Order :--

1. As from the specified date Order N.I.Bk. (149), as amended, Statutory shall have effect subject to the further amendments set out in the minimum remuneration. Schedule to this Order.

2. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the Commence-3rd day of November, 1952. Provided that where, as respects any ment worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.
