The first day of April, 1952, shall be and is hereby appointed as the day on which the provisions of Part III of the Act subsequent to Section 10 shall come into operation.

Foyle Area (Control of Netting) Regulations, 1952

REGULATIONS DATED 9TH APRIL, 1952, MADE BY THE FOYLE FISHERIES COMMISSION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE OF THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND AND THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT, 1952, AND SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1952.

The Foyle Fisheries Commission hereinafter referred to as "the Commission" in exercise of its powers under Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952 and Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1952, hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Control of Netting) Regulations, 1952.

2. In these regulations —

"the Foyle Area" has the meaning given to it in the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952 and the Foyle Fisheries (Northern Ireland) Act, 1952,

"licensee" means the holder of a licence issued by the Commission authorising the use of a draft net in any part of the Foyle Area, and

"fishing station" means any place within the Foyle Area at which a licensee shoots and hauls a draft net and includes the area within a radius of 100 yards from such place.

3.—(1) A licensee using a draft net in the fishing waters on completing the hauling thereof at any fishing station shall not again shoot such net at that station until every other licensee who may be waiting to fish at such station shall have shot and hauled his draft net.

(2) A licensee shall not be permitted to occupy for more than one hour any fishing station in the fishing waters at which other licensees are waiting their turns to fish.

4.—(1) Each and every boat used for netting for salmon and trout in any part of the Foyle Area shall have painted on each side of the bow with distinct figures of not less than six inches in length and one inch in breadth a number corresponding with the number on the licence issued for the net used with the said boat.

(2) The said numbers shall be painted in white oil colour on a black background.

(3) The said numbers shall not be effaced, covered or concealed in any manner whatsoever.

(4) No boat shall have painted on its bows more than one number.

5. The River Foyle (Fishing by Holders of Special Local Licences) Regulations, 1949 (S.I. No. 106 of 1949) and River Foyle Bye-Law No. 476, 1950, are hereby revoked.
