**The Foot-and-Mouth Disease No. V Order
(Northern Ireland), 1952**

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Act 1894, as amended and adapted by any subsequent enactments and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. Unless and until it is otherwise ordered by the Ministry, swill shall not be landed in Northern Ireland from any vessel except under a licence granted by the Ministry, and subject to such conditions as may be specified in the licence.

Offences

2. Any person committing or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of any breach of the provisions of this Order is liable, on summary conviction, to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts 1894-1948.

Commencement

3. This Order shall come into operation on the date hereof.

Short Title

4. This Order may be cited as "The Foot-and-Mouth Disease No. V Order (Northern Ireland) 1952".
