8. Where as a direct result of the purchase of equipment to which sub-paragraph (c) of Regulation 4 of these Regulations refers any existing equipment in a school becomes available for disposal the Ministry may take into account the value of the equipment available for disposal in determining the amount of the expenditure on which grant may be paid.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 29, 30, 104 and 106 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Handicapped Pupils and Special Schools (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1953
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1953.
- 2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Handicapped Pupils and Special Schools Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.
- 3. For Regulation 12 (f) of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Regulation:—
 - "(f) be open during the school year for at least 187 days (exclusive of Sundays) of which not more than five days may be

counted in any one calendar week from Sunday to Saturday inclusive: provided that in exceptional circumstances the Ministry may sanction an alteration of this number upon application made by a Principal or other approved authority of the school; and "
