## WAKEHURST

WHEREAS by paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) of section five of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1951 (a), the Governor of Northern Ireland is empowered to designate by Order in Council a class of employment as pensionable employment for the purposes of that sub-section, where the Ministry of Finance is satisfied that the employment entitles a person therein employed to superannuation benefits substantially similar to those conferred by or under the Superannuation Acts.

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Finance is satisfied that employment in Great Britain which is pensionable by virtue of sub-section (1) of section sixty-seven of the National Health Service Act, 1946 (b), or sub-section (1) of section sixty-six of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act, 1947 (c), entitles a person therein employed to superannuation benefits substantially similar to those conferred by or under the Superannuation Acts.
