Contributions and Grants

1. The Housing (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland), 1952 (a), shall have effect as if for the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-three" in Articles 1 and 2 of the said Order, there were substituted the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-four."

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Citation

3. This Order may be cited as the Housing (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland), 1953, and shall, subject to the provisions of sub-section (5) of section fifteen of the No. 2 Act of 1946, have effect from the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

Grants in respect of farm houses and of approved workers' houses

ORDER * DATED 30TH JANUARY, 1953, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 12 OF THE HOUSING ON FARMS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the approval of

the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section twelve of the Housing on Farms Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, (in this Order referred to as "the Act") and of every other power it thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following order :—

Grants for provision of new farmhouses

1. The amount of grant payable under section one of the Act in respect of a new farmhouse completed before the fourth day of February nineteen hundred and fifty-five in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry, and so certified by an officer of the Ministry and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified opposite each category in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for provision of houses for approved workers

2. The amount of grant payable under Section four of the Act in respect of an approved worker's house completed before the fourth day of February nineteen hundred and fifty-five in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry, and so certified by an officer of the Ministry and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for reconditioning as farmhouses and approved workers' houses

3. The amount of grant payable under section seven of the Act in respect of the reconditioning of any premises for use as a farmhouse or approved worker's house or houses completed before the fourth day of February nineteen hundred and fifty-five in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry, and so certified by an officer of the Ministry and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

4. The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

5. This Order may be cited as the Housing on Farms (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland), 1953, and shall, subject to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section twelve of the Act have effect from the fifth day of February nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

Where the superficial area of the new farmhouse exceeds eight hundred square feet and does not exceed nine hundred square feet	£350
Where the superficial area of the new farmhouse exceeds nine hundred square feet and does not exceed fifteen hundred square feet	£420

SECOND SCHEDULE

Category of House	Amount of Grant payable by the Ministry
<i>New Houses for Approved Workers</i>	
In the case of a house having three apartments and a superficial area of not more than eight hundred square feet	£500
In the case of a house having four apartments and a superficial area of not more than nine hundred square feet	£550
In the case of a house having five apartments and a superficial area of not more than one thousand and fifty square feet	£600

THIRD SCHEDULE

Category of House	Amount of Grant payable by the Ministry
<i>Reconditioning Premises as Farmhouses</i>	
Where the aggregate net annual value of all agricultural lands and agricultural buildings owned or occupied by the Applicant does not exceed £35 and the approved cost of reconditioning exceeds £50	Two-thirds of the amount by which the cost of the work exceeds £50, subject to a maximum grant of £300.
Where the aggregate net annual value of all agricultural lands and agricultural buildings owned or occupied by the Applicant exceeds £35 but does not exceed £100 and the approved cost of reconditioning exceeds £75	Two-thirds of the amount by which the cost of the work exceeds £75, subject to a maximum grant of £300.
<i>Reconditioning Premises as Approved Workers' Houses</i>	
Where the approved cost of reconditioning exceeds £75	Two-thirds of the amount by which the cost of the work exceeds £75, subject to a maximum grant of £300.
