

Housing Subsidy Order

ORDER,* DATED 28TH APRIL, 1953, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE HOUSING (NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section one of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of every other power it thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order :—

1. In the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1952 (a), (which provides for the number and amount of contributions payable—
 - (a) by the Ministry to a local authority under section one of the Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1945 (in this Order referred to as "the Act of 1945");
 - (b) by a local authority to the credit of their Housing Revenue Account under section two of the Act of 1945 ;
 - (c) by the Ministry to the Northern Ireland Housing Trust under subsections (1) and (2) of section sixteen of the Act of 1945 ; or
 - (d) by the Ministry to a housing association under the said section one of the Act of 1945 as applied to housing associations by virtue of section twelve of the Housing and Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946).

for the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-three" where they appear in the said Order there shall be substituted the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-four" and in Article 3 of the said Order there shall be substituted for the words "and the amount of the annual contribution payable by the local authority to the credit of their Housing Revenue Account in respect of each such part shall be the sum of nine pounds" the words "and the amount of the annual contribution payable by the local authority to the credit of their Housing Revenue Account in respect of each such part shall be the sum of six pounds thirteen shillings and four pence".

2. The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

INDUSTRIAL ASSURANCE

Industrial Assurance (Amendment of Fees) Regulations

1953. No. 64

The Ministry of Commerce in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 43 of the Industrial Assurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1924 (a), and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Industrial Assurance (Amendment of Fees) Regulations, (Northern Ireland) 1953 and shall come into operation on the 27th day of April, 1953.

2. In lieu of the fees imposed under the Industrial Assurance Act, (Northern Ireland) 1924, for the several matters set out hereunder by virtue of the Industrial Assurance (Fees) Regulation, (Northern Ireland) 1924, (b) there shall be imposed the fees hereby respectively provided for such matters and the aforesaid Regulation shall be amended accordingly :—
