EDUCATION

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Nursery Schools (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1953.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1953.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Nursery Schools Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.

3. For Regulation 11 (1) of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following Regulation :---

"11.—(1) A nursery school shall be open for not less than 200 school days in each school year : provided that in exceptional circumstances the Ministry may approve a lesser number of days of opening."

14. The teaching and nursery assistant staff of a nursery school shall be such as the Ministry may from time to time approve, having regard to the actual, or prospective, enrolment.
