AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (5) of Section Seven F of the principal Act notice of the proposal to make an Order and the purport thereof was duly given on the 1st day of June, 1954;

AND WHEREAS objections to the making of the Order have been received;

AND WHEREAS the said objections have been duly considered by me:

Now, THEREFORE, I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE GEORGE B. HANNA, Q.C., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by Section Seven of the principal Act as amended by Section Two of the Game Law Amendment Act (Northern Ireland), 1951, hereby Order and Direct as follows, that is to say:—

1. It shall be unlawful for any person wilfully to take, kill or destroy any snipe during the period commencing on the first day of February in any year and ending with the thirty-first day of August next following.

2. This Order shall have effect as and from the 1st day of September, 1954.

REGULATIONS, DATED 7TH SEPTEMBER, 1954, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

General Dental Services

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section eleven of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (General Dental Services) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1954, and shall be deemed to have had effect from the first day of April, 1954.

(2) The Health Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 to 1953, and these Regulations may be cited together as the Health Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 to 1954.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The Health Services (General Dental Services Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended as follows:—

For item 22 of Part I of the scale of fees set out in the Schedule there shall be substituted the following:—

"22. Arrest of bleeding, including bleeding following treatment provided otherwise than as part of general dentai services:--feeper case payable only where the service is provided on an occasion subsequent to that on which the extractions were carried out
