

Small Dwellings Acquisition—Limit of Market Value

ORDER, DATED 1ST OCTOBER, 1954, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE SMALL DWELLINGS ACQUISITION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the consent of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section one of the Small Dwellings Acquisition Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Small Dwellings Acquisition (Market Value) Order (Northern Ireland), 1954.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The limit on the market value of houses in respect of which advances may be made under the Small Dwellings Acquisition Acts (Northern Ireland), 1899 to 1948, shall be increased from two thousand five hundred pounds to five thousand pounds.

3. The Small Dwellings Acquisition (Market Value) Order (Northern Ireland), 1950, (a) is hereby revoked.
