

ORDER, DATED 28TH OCTOBER, 1954, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section ten of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs:—

That the Petty Sessions District of Tynan shall as from the eighth day of November, 1954, be transferred to, and become part of, the Petty Sessions District of Armagh, and, in consequence of such transfer, the said Petty Sessions District of Tynan is hereby abolished.
