REGULATIONS, DATED 3RD DAY OF MARCH, 1954, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1929.

The Ministry of Commerce in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 8 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, and of all other powers in that behalf thereunto enabling it hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Lisburn, County Antrim) Regulations, 1954.

2. A person shall not, except by the express direction or permission of a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, drive or propel a vehicle of any kind whatsoever in any street or length of street in the Urban District of Lisburn in the County of Antrim specified in the Schedule to these Regulations except in the direction prescribed in relation to that street in the Schedule.
