AND WHEREAS objections to the making of the Order have been received:

AND WHEREAS the said objections have been duly considered by me.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE GEORGE B. HANNA, Q.C., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section seven of the principal Act as amended by section four of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, and of all other powers in that behalf me thereunto enabling, hereby Order and Direct as follows, that is to say:—

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or to have in his possession for the purpose of sale, for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere by human beings or animals, any wild bird or wild fowl, except wood-pigeon, grouse, partridge, pheasant, heath or moor game, snipe and woodcock:

2. This Order shall remain in force for a period of three years from the 8th day of August, 1954, unless previously revoked.

THE WASTE OF AGRICULTURAL FOODSTUFFS (REVOCATION) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1954, DATED JANUARY 15, 1954.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, delegated to it by the Delegation of Emergency Powers (Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland) (No. 2)

Order, 1943(a), made by the Secretary of State under paragraph (1) of Regulation 102A of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945(b), (as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947(c), and the Supplies and Services (Defence Purposes) Act, 1951(d), and continued in force by the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1953(e)), and of all other powers it enabling, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—This Order may be cited as the Waste of Agricultural Foodstuffs (Revocation) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of March, 1954.

2.—The Waste of Agricultural Foodstuffs (Northern Ireland) Order, 1942(f), is hereby revoked.
